A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE CLUB



With the support of the Local Board of the then North Shore City Council, Beach Haven Bowling Club (Inc) was first established on 29th April, 1993 by a group of local residents who had identified a need for a Bowling Club at Shepherds Park. The Club finally opened its doors in 1996 with a small Clubhouse, a single Implements Shed and a green cared for by the members.

Since then the Clubhouse has been doubled in size (1999/2000) and the green fenced to protect the turf and provide shade and shelter for players and visitors (2011). A second shed was added (2018) with upgrades made to the pathways around the green in the same year. The deck was also fully extended, greatly improving access to the Clubhouse for all concerned, and the green was re-turfed to North Harbour and New Zealand Bowls specifications during the winter of 2018, providing us with a much improved playing surface to complement the new facilities. We are therefore confident we can be favourably compared with any small urban club in the country with the unique bonus of being located in beautifully wooded surroundings.

None of this work would have been possible without input from our community. We enjoy the support of Individuals, local businesses, Birkenhead Licensing Trust and Local Government. As a result we have developed into a lively and respected club with a reputation for friendliness and hospitality for visitors.

Consistent with Bowls NZ and in line with Clause 8.2. of the BNH Centre Constitution, BHBC provide that:

“All matches shall be played in accordance with the Laws of the Sport and Regulations as approved by Bowls NZ, and the Club and its members shall, as a condition of the continuance of membership to Bowls NZ, at all times and all respects conform to and be bound by the Constitution of Bowls NZ.

BOWLS ETIQUETTE

Acts of courtesy between and among players, on and off the green, contribute greatly to the enjoyment of our wonderful sport. A player's consideration for their opponent and others is reflected in their reputation and standing in the Club. You will discover the players at the very top are frequently those who are most courteous in their approach to the game and who are gracious in both victory and defeat.

Here are some important pointers:

- Dress in accordance with Club rules for proper attire.
- Be punctual and introduce yourself to fellow team members with a smile.
- Show hospitality to visitors when you are playing at your home club.
- Compliment your opponent when he plays a good shot and admit good fortune when you fluke a shot- "We all get'em don't we? But they're welcome when our luck's in". Hand your opponent the jack or mat when it is his turn to lead.
- Pay attention to keeping the score as required. Do not encroach on any adjoining rink when delivering your bowl.
- Remember always your opponent has possession of the rink as soon as the bowl you have delivered comes to rest.
- Do not interfere with or distract your opponent - you should be 2 metres behind the mat when he has the mat.
- Watch your shadow does not fall across the line your opponent wishes to take. If you are standing on the head, do not allow your shadow to shade the jack.
- Pay close attention to your skip when you are on the mat so that you are prepared for his directions.

BOWLS ETIQUETTE (Cont.)

- Support and encourage your team members, especially when they are having a bad day. Don't demean your team or criticize any team member. Be positive.
- Help to clear the head AFTER the result has been determined.
- Do not precede the player who played the last bowl at crossover - allow him to follow the path of his bowl.
- Do not waste time in a time limit game. Give the opposition a fair go. At crossover do not linger on the head thereby obstructing the skip's first bowl.
- Observe the laws regarding following your bowl up the rink and do not be in the way when your opponent has possession of the rink.
- At the end of a day's play help return scrims, mats, jacks and clean scoreboards to storage.

Substitutes/Replacements

Any Substitute or Replacement approved by the controlling body (the Match Committee in the case of Club Championships) shall be a Player who is a Full Member of the Club and where possible has not already been a participant in the Championship or Tournament, and where practicable, is of playing ability equal to or less than that of the absent Members of the Team. No Substitute or Replacement will be permitted for any Player who commences play in a Championship or Tournament knowing he is unable to complete the event

BOWLS ETIQUETTE (Cont.)

POINTS ABOUT LEADING

- 1 The mat should be laid correctly with the rink in line with the centre line of the mat and the front edge no less than two metres from the rear ditch and not less than 25 metres from the front ditch except when scrimms are used, then at two metres only from the rear ditch. As soon as the head is decided (if in your favour) acquire the mat and the jack and lay the mat without wasting time. Assist in getting the bowls back and make sure your own bowls are handy, so that you are ready to play as soon as the jack is straightened!
- 2 Try to deliver the jack to the length directed by your skip as this may be the length your team uses most successfully, or the length your skip might think will put off your opposition.
- 3 You are a very important member of the team in that you are the one to lay the foundation for each head. You are the one to bring initial pressure on the opposition. If you can do this in every head, your team has a good chance of winning.
- 4 A good lead can play both hands equally well through practice and should be able to play the “good” hand as dictated by the skip who will have been watching the behaviour of all the bowls over the first few ends.
- 5 If the opponent has drawn a close shot, a good lead should concentrate on drawing close second UP to the head and should not start trying to run at shot bowl.
- 6 Practice regularly delivering the jack to short, medium or long lengths.
